Before the mid-nineteenth century, people in the United States ate most foods only <u>in season</u>. Drying, smoking, and salting could preserve meat for a short time, but the availability of fresh meat, like that of fresh milk, was very limited; there was no way to prevent spoilage. But in 1810 a French inventor named Nicolas Appert developed the cooking-and-sealing process of canning. And in the 1850's an American named Gail Borden developed a means of condensing and preserving milk. Canned goods and condensed milk became more common during the 1860's, but supplies remained low because cans had to be made by hand. By 1880, however, inventors had fashioned stamping and soldering machines that mass-produced cans from a metal material called tinplate. Suddenly all kinds of food could be preserved and bought at all times of the year.

Other inventions had also helped make it possible for Americans to vary their daily diets. Growing urban populations created demand that encouraged fruit and vegetable farmers to raise more produce. Railroad refrigerator cars enabled growers and meat producers to ship their products great distances and to preserve them for longer periods. Thus, northern cities inhabitants could enjoy southern and western fruits and vegetables, previously available for a month at most, for up to six months of the year. In addition, increased use of iceboxes enabled families to store perishables*. An easy means of producing ice commercially had been invented in the 1870's, and by 1900 the nation had more than two thousand commercial ice plants, most of which made home deliveries. The icebox became essential in most homes and remained so until the mechanized refrigerator replaced it in the 1920's and 1930's.

To follow the "better safe than sorry "rule, people should know how to determine the shelf life of foods. Fresh meats usually only last in the refrigerator for 1 or 2 days, but can last for a few months in the freezer. So, where your food will be stored will determine how long of a shelf life you can expect it to have. Inspect food packaging and wrapping for any tears or leaks, as this could significantly lower the shelf life of food or make <u>it</u> unsafe to consume. Throw away vegetables that are discoloured or have a sour smell, as these are probably beginning to rot. Meat that is discoloured should be discarded. Moreover, all perishable foods have expiration dates on their outer packaging to serve as a guide for determining the shelf life of the food. This date is usually near the bar code or nutritional information label on the packaging.





Fasting is part of the practices of many religions including Islam, Christianity and Judaism. Fasting Ramadan is one of the main pillars of Islam .Today, many people are trying to discover the benefits of fasting. Some people fast for spiritual reasons ,while others fast as a way to physically discipline the body. Whatever reasons one might come up with, it has been scientifically proved that fasting has <u>tremendous</u> healthy, spiritual and social benefits.

First, fasting plays an important role in the detoxification of the body. Detoxification is a normal body process of removing or neutralizing toxins or harmful things through the colon, liver, kidneys, lungs, skin and other organs. As food no longer enters the body, <u>it</u> turns to fat reserves for energy. When the fat reserves are used during fast, the body releases the chemicals from the fatty acids into the system which are then removed through the body organs, leading to the cleansing of the whole body.

Another benefit of fasting is the healing process that is obvious in the body during a fast. When fasting, energy is diverted away from the digestive system due to its lack of use and moves towards the metabolism process and immune system. The healing process during a fast is made easy by the body's search for energy sources. Abnormal growths within the body, tumours and the like, do not have the full support of the body's supplies and therefore are more likely to disappear.

Fasting also has spiritual and social benefits . It leads to a feeling of new youth and extended life expectancy. This might be due to the detoxification effect of fasting. A study showed that fasting leads to the extension of life. The experiment was performed by isolating one *earthworm and putting it on a cycle of fasting and feeding. The isolated earthworm outlived the other earthworms by generations, while still maintaining its freshness and youthful physiological characteristics. Moreover, fasting enables the wealthier members of the society to realize the bad conditions of the poor. They feel sorry for them and begin to do something for their welfare. This produces acts of charity which arouse a feeling of happiness and gratitude amongst the poor for their rich brothers and sisters. Cooperation among rich Muslims and poor ones is at its best during Ramadan . All these good acts that are generated by fasting contribute to the improvement and empowerment of the society as a whole.

Fasting is part of the practices of many religions including Islam, Christianity and Judaism. Fasting Ramadan is one of the main pillars of Islam .Today, many people are trying to discover the benefits of fasting. Some people fast for spiritual reasons ,while others fast as a way to physically discipline the body. Whatever reasons one might come up with , it has been scientifically proved that fasting has <u>tremendous</u> healthy, spiritual and social benefits.

First, fasting plays an important role in the detoxification of the body. Detoxification is a normal body process of removing or neutralizing toxins or harmful things through the colon, liver, kidneys, lungs, skin and other organs. As food no longer enters the body, <u>it</u> turns to fat reserves for energy. When the fat reserves are used during fast, the body releases the chemicals from the fatty acids into the system which are then removed through the body organs, leading to the cleansing of the whole body.

Another benefit of fasting is the healing process that is obvious in the body during a fast. When fasting, energy is diverted away from the digestive system due to its lack of use and moves towards the metabolism process and immune system. The healing process during a fast is made easy by the body's search for energy sources. Abnormal growths within the body, tumours and the like, do not have the full support of the body's supplies and therefore are more likely to disappear.

Fasting also has spiritual and social benefits . It leads to a feeling of new youth and extended life expectancy. This might be due to the detoxification effect of fasting. A study showed that fasting leads to the extension of life. The experiment was performed by isolating one *earthworm and putting it on a cycle of fasting and feeding. The isolated earthworm outlived the other earthworms by generations, while still maintaining its freshness and youthful physiological characteristics. Moreover, fasting enables the wealthier members of the society to realize the bad conditions of the poor. They feel sorry for them and begin to do something for their welfare. This produces acts of charity which arouse a feeling of happiness and gratitude amongst the poor for their rich brothers and sisters. Cooperation among rich Muslims and poor ones is at its best during Ramadan . All these good acts that are generated by fasting contribute to the improvement and empowerment of the society as a whole.




